## How to get to IBIS POLITEHNICA Hotel

### BY PLANE

Bucharest has only one international airport - Henri Coanda international airport (OTP), which is located around 15 kilometers away from the city center of Bucharest.

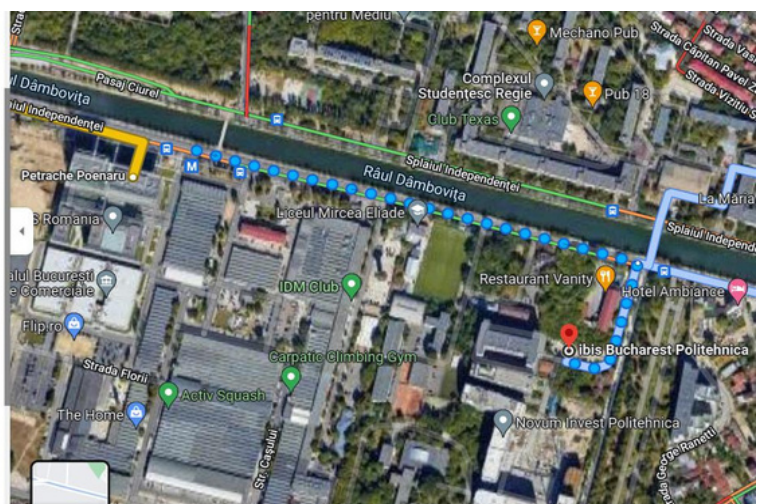
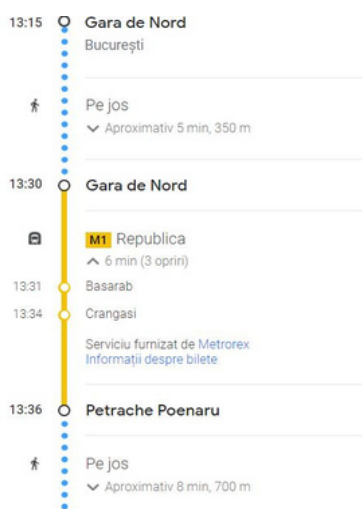
### How to get from the airport to the hotel

**BY TRAIN:** From the airport you can reach Bucharest North Train Station by train.

The trains run 24 hours a day, every 40 minutes and a trip takes 25 minutes.

From Gara de Nord Train station, you have to take the Metro - line M1 (Direction Republica. The Metro entrance is next to KFC. You have to travel 3 stops and get off at Petrache Poenaru stop. ### **BY TAXI/BOLT/UBER**

You can use the counters for ordering taxis in the arrival hall at the airport or use Bolt/Uber app. You should be able to pay in cash for TAXI! If you choose taxi, before to start your journey ask the driver for price and also ask for bill/receipt.

**Money:** the Romanian currency is called LEU (RON). The current exchange rate is 1 EUR = 4,94 RON. **Payments are accepted only in RON not in EURO.** It might be that you need to pay in cash in bars or coffee houses, but usually payment with card is possible too.
